



RoHS Compliance Statement

At Aristech Surfaces, we are committed to the safety and health of our employees, contractors, customers, and neighbors, and to the sustainability and the protection of the environment. We endeavor to employ relevant practices that reduce our environmental footprint while promoting an environmentally responsible culture with employees and suppliers alike.

As a responsible supplier of acrylic sheet products worldwide, Aristech Surfaces is committed to helping our customers comply with important regulations that may affect them. The European Union's RoHS Delegated Directive (EU) 2015/863 may potentially impact our customers and we wish to explain the use of Aristech products and compliance with this directive.

The restricted substances referred to in Article 4(1) of the Directive and maximum concentration values tolerated by weight in homogeneous materials are as follows:

- Lead (0.1 %)
- Mercury (0.1 %)
- Cadmium (0.01 %)
- Hexavalent chromium (0.1 %)
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) (0.1 %)
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) (0.1 %)
- Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) (0.1 %)
- Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP) (0.1 %)
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) (0.1 %)
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) (0.1 %)

Aristech Surfaces has thoroughly investigated all the ingredients used in the manufacture of our acrylic sheet products and these products have no intentional addition of the restricted substances listed above, and we do not expect the concentration of the restricted substances to be above the maximum concentration values.
