Re: California Proposition 65 Labeling Compliance

Dear Customer,

The state of California's Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, better known as Proposition 65, requires businesses operating in the state of California to provide adequate warnings about exposure to, or the discharge of, chemicals that cause cancer or reproductive toxicity. On August 30, 2018, an amendment to the current regulation will be implemented that changes how warning labels should be displayed to the public.

California's Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment publishes a list of chemicals known to the state to cause cancer or reproductive toxicity, most recently updated on 19 March, 2021. The list includes cadmium compounds and nickel compounds, identifying both as known by the state to cause cancer. Aristech Surfaces LLC utilizes pigments that contain these compounds in certain products which appear in trace amounts and would not be expected to pose significant risk; however, a risk assessment for these chemicals has not been performed.

Effective August 2018, Aristech will apply a Proposition 65 warning label (shown below) to all pallets of its product being shipped to the state of California. Individual sheets will not be labeled.
